

### 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter Homework Explanation

Many of the activities on the homework are similar to the ones from the last two quarters. Here are some instructions for some of the newer spelling activities.

**Rhyming Words-** Write each of your spelling words and then write a word that rhymes with each word. Here is the fun part, the rhyming words do not have to be real words, but they do have to rhyme.

Example:    Spelling Word        Rhyming Words  
                  butter                    splutter, shutter, clutter, flutter, putter

**Military Spelling** - Try to memorize your spelling words using the Military Alphabet code.

A= Alpha	B= Bravo	C=Charlie	D= Delta	E= Echo	F= Foxtrot

Example: To spell the word, book, try to remember the military code for the word by repeating or writing    Bravo Oscar Oscar Kilo

**Newspaper/Magazine Words** - Look through newspapers and magazines to find the letters in your spelling words. Practice spelling the words by cutting out the letters and gluing them on a sheet of paper.

**Shape Words** – Use your spelling words to draw shapes on a piece of paper.

Example: small, ball, tall, call, fall, mall, brawl, crawl
