## **3rd Quarter Homework Explanation**

**Rhyming Words-** Write each of your spelling words and then write a word that rhymes with each word. Here is the fun part, the rhyming words do not have to be real words, but they do have to rhyme.

**Military Spelling -** Try to memorize your spelling words using the Military Alphabet code.

Example: To spell the word, book, try to remember the military code for the word by repeating or writing Bravo Oscar Oscar Kilo

**Newspaper/Magazine Words -** Look through newspapers and magazines to find the letters in your spelling words. Practice spelling the words by cutting out the letters and gluing them on a sheet of paper.

**Shape Words –** Use your spelling words to draw shapes on a piece of paper.

Example: small, ball, tall, call, fall, mall, brawl, crawl
